Summer Enrichment Experience (SEE) Camp began in 1990 and is an annual two-week academic day camp for high-achieving students in grades three through eight. SEE Camp offers programs that positively challenge student abilities and provides opportunities to connect with peers with similar interests. Activities are provided to promote social and emotional growth.

Areas of study include science, math, social science, computer science, foreign language, journalism, vocal music, art, dance, and drama.

Some class topics that may be offered include: Brain Busters, Criminal Justice, History Mysteries, Engineering Small Machines, Chemistry, Edible Experiments, Drama Theatre, Choir, Yearbook and Newspaper Creation, Spanish and Write It-Draw It.
